GIPPSLAND LIFELINE MESSAGE FROM MICHELLE

To our amazing line dancing community (who we consider part of the Lifeline Gippsland family)!

Every year we think it just couldn't be possible to top the year before, and every year you prove us wrong. Those of you who have been part of this community, this family, for the years that you have supported us will know that I often say that it's only your efforts that leave me struggling for words. Every year that is true. For any newcomers, I'm sure Linda and Sue have made you aware that we receive only 25 per cent of the funding required just to respond to 13 11 14 crisis phone line calls. For the rest of the work we do in the community, which includes community awareness raising, training and supporting people who have lost loved ones to suicide, we don't receive any funding. It is genuinely through the generosity of people like you that we can keep the lights on, keep responding to people in their times of need and make sure that when people are facing their darkest hour, there is someone there to listen at the other end of the phone.

Your commitment to people who are struggling through darkness and hard times is unmatched, and we are humbled and honoured to continue to be the incredibly lucky beneficiary of your fundraising efforts.

We plan to use your enormous donation to offset the cost of training our crisis support phone volunteers, which is \$4,000 per person.

We can break down your incredible contribution as follows:

- Five people trained equals 72 hours of volunteering per year
- 72 hours volunteering equals an average of 144 calls answered
- The five people you have funded for training will answer 720 calls per year
 - Those five people stay with us, on average, for five years

That means the total calls you have helped to fund is a staggering 3,600. That's 3,600 people who, because of you, will not have to go through their struggles alone. Each call may be a life saved.

Thank you just doesn't seem enough, but on behalf of the team, and of the people who need our service and receive it because of your hard work and dedication, please know that our appreciation goes beyond what can be expressed in words. I hope that everyone who contributed, in the countless ways that you do throughout the year is incredibly proud of what you have achieved. You are extraordinary.












- On no account put anything on the floor if it's sticky or slippery, as this can cause harm to a dancer and affect the floor, by deteriorating its surface.
